The Luigi Einaudi Foundation was established in 1964 to "train young scholars in the field of economic, political and historical studies and to develop working tools suited to the needs of a modern society" (from article 2 of the Foundation's Statute). To this end, it awards annual scholarships for young scholars.

CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic Year 2026/2027

1. Characteristics and aims

The Foundation announces 4 annual scholarships for post-doctoral candidates. Applicants must have been born after January 1, 1993. The scholarships to be awarded are in the following fields of research: economic theory, economic policy, modern and contemporary history, economic and social history, political science, with particular attention to Europe and to the following thematic areas:

- a) Development, migration and globalisation processes and their economic, political and social implications, with particular attention to protectionist and free trade policies
- b) History of ideas and history of economic, political and social institutions.

2. Scholarships

The scholarships grants, to be used from October 1, 2026 to September 30, 2027, are as follows:

- 2 scholarships of € 25.000 offered by the Fondazione Luigi Einaudi for studies related to all the subject areas listed;
- 1 scholarship of € 25.000 offered by the San Giacomo Charitable Foundation and named after Roberto Einaudi for studies on globalization and migration processes, economics and institutions in 21st century Europe;
- 1 scholarship of € 25.000 offered by the San Giacomo Charitable Foundation and named after Luigi Einaudi for studies on current economic, social and political affairs.

All scholarships will be awarded by July 15, 2026 by the Foundation's Board of Directors upon proposal of the Scientific Committee.

The criteria followed by the Scientific Committee in the evaluation will be as follows:

- a) consistency of the proposed research with the thematic areas indicated in the call for scholarships;
- b) quality of the curriculum of studies and publications;
- c) innovativeness and originality of the research project presented;
- d) possession of a doctorate or PhD or equivalent degree obtained by 2026. An application will be considered valid if the candidate submits a statement of acceptance indicating that the doctoral thesis has been accepted and will be discussed by November 1, 2026.

3. How to submit applications

Applicants must complete the online application form available in the dedicated section of the Foundation's website (www.fondazioneinaudi.it) **not later than May 31, 2026**, attaching the required documents (in pdf format). In addition, a letter of recommendation drafted by a professor is required and shall be sent to the address provided in the application form.

1. Status of fellows

Fellows who will be assigned a tutor by the Scientific Committee will be required to:

- a) send quarterly reports on the progress of their research to the secretariat of the Fondazione Luigi Einaudi (segreteria@fondazioneinaudi.it) and to their tutor;
- b) present a final paper on their research;
- c) hold a seminar at the Fondazione Luigi Einaudi headquarters to present their research;
- d) provide, in the event that the awarded grant is used in a non-EU country, a duly signed copy of their medical insurance policy at their own expense;
- e) the grantees may carry out other activities compatible with the fulfillment of their research program and subject to a reduction of the monthly grant to an extent established by the Board of Directors. The grant is not compatible with postgraduate grants exceeding € 10.000, with the status of researcher and/or university lecturer;
- f) if the assignee does not continue the activity foreseen by the research program without justified reason or is responsible for serious and repeated violations, the grant may be terminated;
- g) spend at least 4 months at the Fondazione Luigi Einaudi, using the library resources and participating in the Foundation's activities.

2. Insurance and welfare benefits

If the grant is awarded to non-EU citizens for research to be carried out, in whole or in part, in Italy, the Luigi Einaudi Foundation shall receive a copy of the medical insurance policy taken out at the expense of the grantee or, alternatively, a copy of his/her registration with the National Health Service. This documentation shall be provided upon acceptance of the grant by the grantee. The Luigi Einaudi Foundation shall not assume any charge for health and welfare benefits for illness, accident or maternity that the grantee may incur during his/her stay in Italy.
